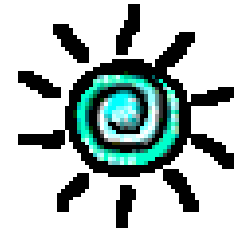

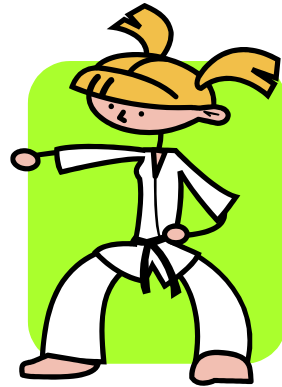
What is Safety?

Bike Safety Guidelines

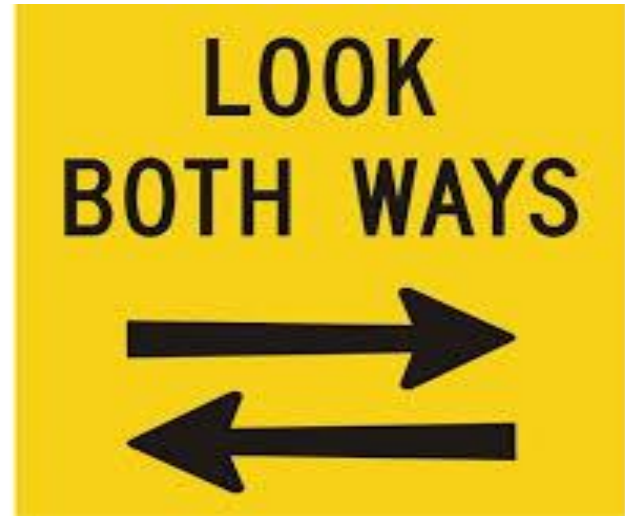


- 1. Always wear your helmet**
Bikers without helmets are 14x more likely to be in a fatal accident!
- 2. Wear neon colors and reflective materials**
It makes it easier to be seen by others!
- 3. Bikers should always ride on the right side of the road**
Go with the traffic!
- 4. Obey traffic laws**
The same ones that apply to motor vehicles!
- 5. If it's night, ride with a light**
Even if it's just for a few feet!

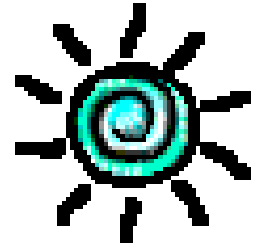
